Objectives

- Describe the key aspects of assertiveness, communication, time management, delegation, performance appraisal, and complaint management that impact effective management
- List actions helpful in managing complaints - Identify major legal risks in long term care nursing
 - Describe actions to reduce legal risks - Identify sources of stress in long term care nursing

Requirements for Obtaining the LPN-CLTC™ Certificate

To obtain the certificate and 10 contact hours, LPNs must:

- Hold an active license as a licensed practical nurse
- Be employed in a long term care facility
- Attend the entire workshop
- Pass the examination with a score of at least 80%

Participants will be given a take home test that they are to take on their own and then send to the American Association for Long Term Care Nursing to fulfill the LPN-CLTC™ Certificate requirements
